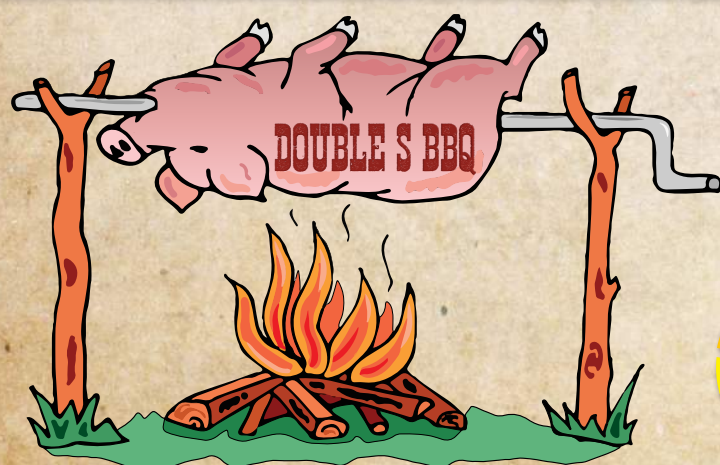

2019 STRIPED BASS DERBY

NCGASA Striper Derby Rules

1. All Participants (Adults & Youths) must be paid for derby before 5 am of the event April 20th. Payments can be made via PayPal or in person at disclosed ramp location the morning of event. Derby costs of \$100 will cover the entry to the event, annual membership to NCGASA, BBQ lunch, \$20 raffle tickets, sticker. There is a youth division also for under 16 years old on day of event paying out three winners to slot size and costs \$40. (All ramp Launch fees are NOT INCLUDED)
\$80 Entry if you have current membership. You **MUST BE A MEMBER TO FISH OUR DERBY!** Sign up with entry
2. Payouts will be as followed. **1st place \$3000, 2nd place \$1750, 3rd place \$1000, 4th place \$500, 5th place \$250** (Big Fish payout \$500/ Blind Bogey \$500 Youth payout 1st place \$300, 2nd place \$200, 3rd place \$100. All payouts will be written check from NCGASA
3. All people on a derby vessel must be in the derby. For example: IF there are 4 people in a boat they all must be registered in the derby. 2-3 people CANNOT fish as a team for one person. Any cheating on this will be a forfeiture of all monies paid for entrants on that vessel. Only exception is licensed guides do not have to be entered. Any Licensed guide entered into derby must be a member of NCGASA to avoid paying derby entry fee.
4. The boundaries of the 2019 Striper Derby are Verona Launch ramp to Butte City Bridge on Sacramento River and from Verona Launch Ramp to Live Oak Rock Dam on Feather River.
5. The Derby will officially draw the slot limit for the winning MALE fish at 4:45 am sharp and the derby will begin at 5 am. This will take place with 2-3 BOD "LIVE on FaceBook" at 4:45 a.m. and then posted to our Facebook page. Remember Big Fish is MALE ONLY also. ALL FISH CAN ONLY BE MALE.
6. Fishing hours are on April 20th only from 5 am to 3:30 pm. All Entrants must be in line before 3:30 p.m. Weigh In takes place at City of Colusa Public Ramp 50 Tenth St. Colusa, CA and weigh in starts at 2 pm and finishes by 3:30 p.m. All awards and raffle will start after weigh in is complete. Lunch will be served from 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm.
7. Measuring device and scale will be provided by NCGASA board and used for all the same fish. Upon an exact tie in length with 3 Board of Directors confirming a tie. The winner will be decided by weight. All fish within 1" of the target length will be weighed. Biggest weight would take 1st and losing entrant takes 2nd. Upon a 3rd, 4th, or 5th place tie we will take the same direction, except 6th place will not receive any prize money. All disputes will be solved by NCGASA President.
8. Slot Length of a fish is measured from the tip of nose to the fork in the tail. NOTE: the winning fish WILL NOT be measured on total length. Measure your fish from the tip of nose to the inside fork of the tail. We have provided a picture on this flyer.
9. All extra monies and proceeds go to help fight to save our fisheries and wildlife in Northern CA. NCGASA is a 501 (c)3 non-profit organization and all donations are 100% tax write off.

10. All entrants and people helping will derby understand the risks involved with fishing and boating on rivers and are required to follow all CA department of boating and waterways procedures and California Department of Fish and Wildlife rules. All entrants must carry all boating safety equipment on their own vessels. All fish must be caught in the mouth and landed legally by hand or net. All derby fish must be taken to the Colusa Public Ramp for weigh in and measuring location between 2-3:30 p.m. Winners will be subject to Polygraph Test and Local Police investigation upon any form of foul play or cheating by the board of directors.
11. All entrants must follow all local, state and federal laws in this derby. All fish and wildlife laws are required to be followed.
12. Entrants can only measure 1 fish for main slot category. Entrant can entry 2nd fish in big fish or blind bogey category.
13. If winning fish is caught on guide boat then guide receives bonus of \$500.

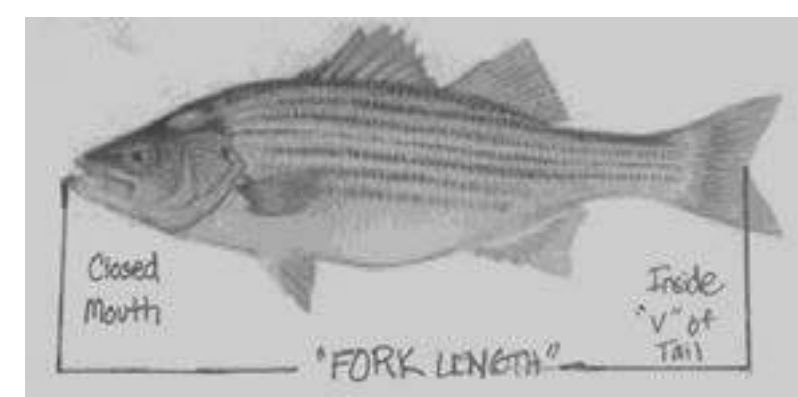
